


Installation Multi-Stall Column Showers





Read this entire installation manual to ensure proper installation. When finished with the installation, file this manual with the owner or maintenance department.

Separate parts from packaging and make sure all parts are accounted for before discarding any packaging material. If any parts are missing, do not begin installation until you obtain the missing parts.



Hardware supplied by installer must be appropriate for wall construction.

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About Your Bradley Multi-Stall Column Showers

Multi-Stall Showers combine all the benefits of Bradley Column Showers with the advantage of showering privacy to serve 2 to 6 persons. Multi-Stall Showers are easy to install, keep clean, and maintain.

Multi-Stall Showers have stainless steel columns, framework and partitions. All units come complete with showers, partitions, framework, curtains, curtain hooks, and all the necessary attaching hardware.

Bradley Multi-Stall Column Showers are durably built for reliable and long-lasting use.

Tools Required by Installer

- Phillips screwdriver
- Level and measuring device
- Hex wrench
- Drill and bits for 5/32" and 1/4" diameter holes into stainless steel

NOTE: When drilling into stainless steel, Bradley recommends the following:

- 1. Use a "Cobalt" drill bit
- 2. Use a 1750 RPM drill speed
- 3. Use cutting oil
- Drill and bits for 3/8" diameter holes into floor

A INSTALL YOUR BRADLEY COLUMN SHOWER AS INSTRUCTED IN THE "COLUMN SHO MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS" PROVIDED WITH YOUR NEW MULTI-STALL SHOWER	
B FASTEN THE COLUMN BRACKETS TO THE COLUMN SHOWER USING THE 1/4"-20 X 5 PROVIDED. SEE FIGURE 1.	7/16" BUTTON HEAD SCREWS
POSITION THE PARTITIONS SO THE TOP OF THE PARTITION IS EVEN WITH THE TIP OF 1/4" SPACE EXISTS BETWEEN THE PARTITION AND COLUMN SHOWER. SUPPORT PAFIGURE 1.	
D MAKE SURE THE PARTITIONS ARE LEVEL AND PLUMB.	
USING THE COLUMN BRACKETS AS TEMPLATES, DRILL 1/4" DIAMETER HOLES INTO) THE PARTITIONS.
AFTER THE HOLES ARE DRILLED INTO THE PARTITIONS, SECURE THE PARTITIONS USING THE #10-24 X 1/2" BUTTON HEAD SCREWS AND SPACERS PROVIDED. NOTE: A BUTTON HEAD SCREWS BEFORE INSTALLING PARTITION.	
G FASTEN THE POST BRACKETS TO THE POSTS AT THE SAME VERTICAL HEIGHT AS T THE COLUMN (SEE FIGURE 2). FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS IN FIGURE 2.	THE BRACKETS MOUNTED TO
#10-24 x 1/2" Button Head Screw (160-138) Spacer (182-051)	Post Drill 5/32" Diameter Holes In Stainless Steel Using Bracket as a Template Post Bracket (140-057)
