IMPORTANT!



Read this entire installation manual to ensure proper installation. When finished with the installation, file this manual with the owner or maintenance department. Compliance and conformity to local codes and ordinances is the responsibility of the installer.



Separate parts from packaging and make sure all parts are accounted for before discarding packaging material. If any parts are missing, do not begin installation until you obtain the missing parts.



Make sure that all water supply lines have been completely turned off before beginning installation.

Accu-Zone Electrical Connections




Solenoid will require access from plumbing chase or access panel.

TouchTime® Electrical Connections



Solenoid will require access from plumbing chase or access panel.

Install a 24 VAC Class II transformer in a remote location a safe distance from the shower room. Connect the wire designated 24VAC to transformer.



The wires can be connected to the solenoid in any order.



Connect the gray and white/blue wires to the solenoid valve connectors.




Verify that the electrical source to fixture is 24VA


CAUTION Do not turn 24VAC power on to shower until installation is complete.



When installation is complete, turn on 24VAC power to shower. Test to make sure water is flowing properly.
